The monument, constructed between 1631 and 1648, is famous as a symbol of eternal love and is one of the most admired and iconic structures in the world.




Red Fort (Lal Qila)

Famous for Independence Day celebrations and stunning Mughal architecture.




Qutub Minar

Humayun's Tomb

Precursor to the Taj Mahal, built in Persian-Mughal style.

Resting place of Mughal Emperor Humayun.

Surrounded by Persian-style gardens and water channels.



About India

India Gate

A 42-meter-high war memorial dedicated to Indian soldiers of WWI. Located on Rajpath and beautifully lit at night. Popular site for locals and tourists alike.



Lotus Temple

A Bahá'í House of Worship known for its lotus-like shape. Open to people of all religions; emphasizes peace and meditation. Surrounded by gardens and reflective pools.



Akshardham Temple:

The world's 2nd-largest Hindu temple. A masterpiece of intricate carvings, majestic domes, and ornate sculptures that pay homage to India's rich architectural heritage. The serene atmosphere, coupled with the melodious chants and peaceful ambiance, creates a conducive environment for introspection and meditation.
